


A courtyard raised bed built to be appreciated from the kitchen bifolds. Planted with structural plants for year round interest and perennial and annuals added.





Same client from previous slide: An island bed in the centre of the main entertaining patio which had an overgrown conifer in it. It was planted for year round interest in the client's favourite colours:






Continued from Slide 4: The courtyard garden being used and how the abundant planting developed over the seasons:





An un-loved, urban front garden that the client wished to turn into a wild-life haven. The garden design with the grass removed and planting for sunny, shady and woodland areas, climbers for the fence and screening from the road. Lots of bee-friendly plants selected.





Continued from slide 6: The structural element of path and stone circle completed and an antique sun dial added which I helped the client buy. The planting is coming on nicely.

A design for a dining and seating area with accompanying planting plan for a contemporary, Italian-style theme in a sunny south-facing patio.







Example of a naturalistic planting plan for a courtyard garden, to provide lots of colour to be seen from the conservatory and other rooms in the house.


